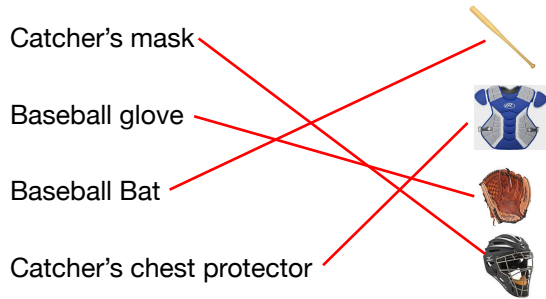


Can you identify the Equipment?

How is your overall general knowledge of baseball?

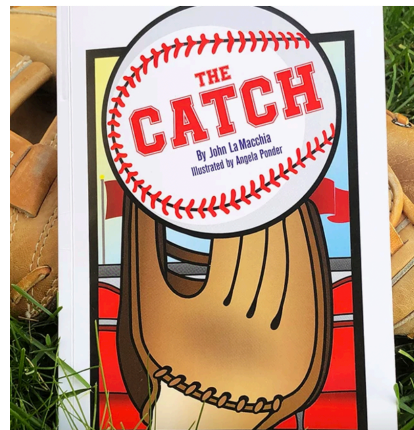
1. How many innings are in a standard MLB game? **9**

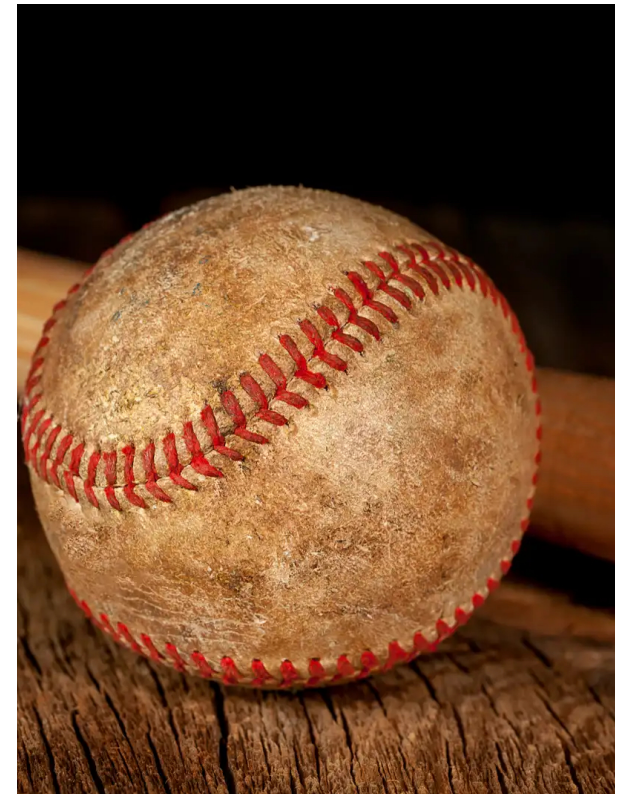

Do You Think You Know Baseball?

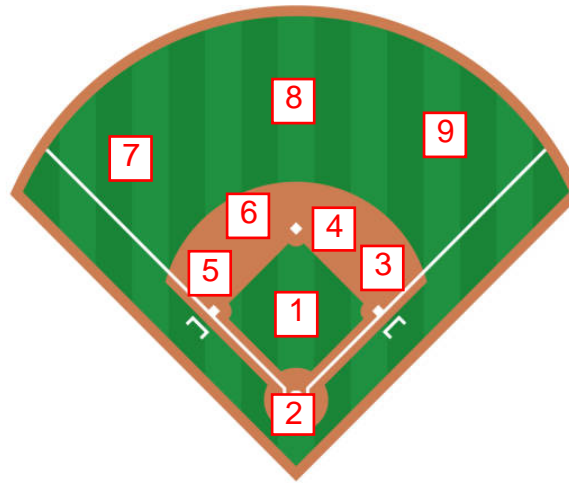


Whether you are an avid fan or someone who has just seen their first game, test your knowledge and understanding of America's favorite pastime!
